Move-out scheduled for 10 a.m.

What is happening today: A team of volunteers will remove all items from the Ward home in preparation for home demolition scheduled for Saturday, June 27. A crew of 35 from the Gannon University Athletic Department will help remove everything from the home. Tri-State Moving Services will transport the furniture and other household items to Birkmire Trucking Company Big Box Storage. All of the Ward family's clothing will be taken by Certified Restoration Drycleaning Network to be laundered.

After the home is emptied, heavy equipment from Mayer Bros. Construction Company will arrive to prepare to raze the home and construction crews will begin setting up their equipment and supplies.
